1.1. Choose Ambulance Billing Vendor

Toby advised we received two bid proposals for the ambulance billing, one from Coastal Medical Billing Inc and one from Comstar. Both bids have a fixed percentage rate of 4% of the actual collections. Coastal Billing does neighboring towns, such as Groton, Ayer and Townsend, and they are happy with the service. Their return rate is 92.8% and information will be sent electronically.
