**TEXTILE DISCUSSION / TAYLOR MILLSPAUGH**

LaFleur welcomed Taylor Millspaugh who is a Director for this organization to this discussion. Millspaugh told the Board that CMRK Organization has been in existence for 35 years. They have donation bins for clothing and anything that will fit in a box. They have 25 trucks that run 7 days a week. The bins are serviced weekly and bins can be customized. They pay \$.07 per pound back to the town. They don't pay for books or household items and they service all of Massachusetts. They take electronics but no garbage or furniture. The Board had some questions which Millspaugh answered with no problem. After discussion, the Board said that they will discuss with the Town Administrator and where the bins should be located. They thanked Millspaugh for speaking with them and said they would get back to her.
