



## Light, Air, Noise Bylaw Committee

### Meeting Minutes

Date: April 4, 2019

Time: 7-9 PM

Location: Conference Room A, Town Hall

Meeting came to order at 7:04 PM.

The minutes of 3/12/19, 3/21/19 and 3/26/19 were reviewed and approved.

The discussion opened with a final review of the noise bylaw draft. The committee does not know where this bylaw may fit within the current zoning bylaws which, it is assumed, will be reviewed and revised sometime in the near future. The committee decided to consider this bylaw as a stand alone document. Harvey Serreze made some edits which he sent to Margaret last night; removed some redundancies. Discussion ensued about the Value and Purpose sections and whether these sections were needed to "sell" the document at town meeting. Mark Little suggested putting the Value paragraph in the beginning with no header. Vince Premus asked whether the paragraph regarding chronic exposure to noise was needed; decision was made to place in the Appendix. Margaret will make final edits to the draft. Vince Premus asked how the document will be approved at town meeting; Ron Karr responded by saying that usually there is a presentation and open question period prior to a final vote; our committee should be prepared to take questions. Several further edits were made to Section 5, E & F regarding costs being borne by the offender rather than the Board of Health; Pat Kenneally suggested leaving the language as if for comment from the Board of Health. P. 7, Section 7 C and D regarding permitting - Margaret Scarsdale will be talking with the Building Inspector for comment.

Final conclusion: Move the value statement that Harvey Serreze drafted and move to the beginning; minor edits to the Purpose were approved; moved chronic exposure language to the Appendix A.

Tony Beattie motioned that the committee submit this draft (with edits as discussed) to town boards for their comments. Motion was passed.

The committee will leave final formatting to Town Counsel.

Margaret Scarsdale then asked the committee about outreach to the various town boards as people know that a draft is forthcoming. Margaret volunteered to talk to the Building Inspector, Fire Chief; Renee D'Argento volunteered to talk with the Board of Health; Joe Radwich to the PBA; Casey Campetti and Tony Beattie to the Planning Board.
