WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW

- Estimated 3 million cubic yards of “regulated” contaminants over 7-9 years
- 8-10 large scale dump trucks per hour traveling on our roads through Dunstable, Tyngsboro, Pepperell, Hollis and Nashua
- Dumping within 200 feet of the Nashua River
- Risk to the aquifer that supplies drinking water to Pepperell residents and our neighbors in Hollis
