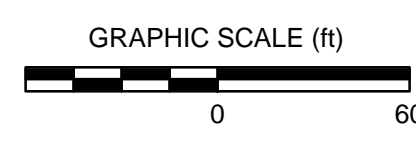




**Existing Conditions

SPECIFICATIONS:
The New England Conservation/Wildlife Mix provides a permanent cover of grasses, wildflowers, and legumes. For both good erosion control and wildlife habitat value. The mix is designed to be a no maintenance seeding, and is appropriate for cut and fill slopes, detention basin side slopes, and disturbed areas adjacent to commercial and residential projects.

APPLICATION RATE: 25 lbs/acre 1750 sq ft/lb

Virginia Wild Rye, (*Elymus virginicus*), Little Bluestem, (*Schizachyrium scoparium*), Creeping Red Fescue, (*Festuca rubra*), Big Bluestem, (*Andropogon gerardii*), Partridge Pea, (*Chamaecrista fasciculata*), Deer Tongue, (*Panicum clandestinum*), Switch Grass, (*Panicum virgatum*), Indian Grass, (*Sorghastrum nutans*), Ox Eye Sunflower, (*Helopsis helianthoides*), New England Aster, (*Symphotichum novae-angliae*), Blue Vervain, (*Verbena hastata*), Upland Bentgrass, (*Agrostis perennans*), Common Milkweed, (*Asclepias syriaca*), Flat Topped/Umbrella Aster, (*Aster umbellatus*), Purple Joe Pye Weed, (*Eupatorium purpure-um*), Early Goldenrod, (*Solidago juncea*), Golden Alexanders, (*Zizia aurea*), Spotted Joe Pye Weed, (*Eupatorium maculatum*).
