I am pleased to inform you that the Department of Energy Resources (DOER) Green Communities Division has approved an award of \$222,005 for the following projects proposed in the Town of Pepperell's Green Communities Competitive Grant application.

List of projects funded:

- \$30,063, Town Hall— Interior lighting
- \$20,452, Library— Exterior lighting
- \$86,173, Varnum Brook Elementary School—Interior and exterior lighting
- \$60,000, Senior Center—Weatherization
- \$4,416, Cemetery Building— Weatherization
- \$4,451, Water Dept.— Weatherization
- \$2,745, Waste Water Dept.— Weatherization
- \$866, Waste Water Dept. Lab— Weatherization
- \$786, Highway— Weatherization
- \$12,053, Town—Administrative costs

The Division reviewed Pepperell's grant application and has determined these are viable projects that meet the eligibility requirements of our Competitive Grant program. **Please note that, due to the competitive nature of this grant program, the use of these funds is restricted to the specifically-approved projects listed above.**
