I am pleased to inform you that the Department of Energy Resources (DOER) Green Communities Division has approved an award of \$250,000 for the following projects proposed in the Town of Pepperell's Green Communities Competitive Grant application.

List of projects funded:

- \$47,742.00, Lawrence Library—Lighting
- \$77,306.00, Nissitissit Middle School—Lighting; Exterior, Gymnasium and Corridors
- \$28,160.00, Public Safety Complex—Lighting
- \$33,807.00, Community Center—Upgrade Furnace & A/C, Fuel Conversion Oil to Natural Gas
- \$24,233.00, Nissitissit Middle School—Weatherization
- \$35,069.00, Highway Dept—Lighting
- \$3,683.00, Town— Administrative Costs

The Division reviewed Pepperell's grant application and has determined these are viable projects that meet the eligibility requirements of our Competitive Grant program. **Please note that, due to the competitive nature of this grant program, the use of these funds is restricted to the specifically-approved projects listed above.**
