- Look for eco-friendly products.
- Read labels carefully & store safely.
- Use products according to directions.
- Use or share products you have.
- Do not buy more than needed

FEES FOR DISPOSAL

Cash and Checks accepted.

- Residents:**
- \$6.50 for each gallon or pound
 - 30 gallons or more, please pre-register

- Businesses:**
- Must pre-register; detail items & sizes
 - Can service very small quantity generator, VSQG
 - Fees depend on products & volume.

HOW TO TRANSPORT SAFELY

- Waste must be visible, accessible, and in a single layer
- Keep materials in original containers.
- Tighten caps and lids.
- Pack in sturdy upright boxes.
- Never smoke while handling hazardous items
- Waste not listed - check for acceptability

on Saratoga Blvd, then see below*

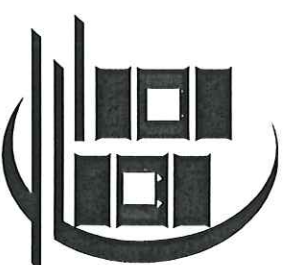
From Ayer Traffic Circle: Right on Barnum Road, right

OTHER ITEMS ACCEPTED

- Batteries-vehicle & other lead acid
- Batteries-button (\$) & rechargeable, accepted if not damaged & contacts taped
- Electronics, TV's, computers, monitors, appliances, most items with a cord (\$)
- Fluorescent bulbs and Mercury items (\$)
- Latex Paint Accepted, but can be treated as regular trash after completely dried (\$)
- Mercury thermometers & thermostats (\$)
- Printer ink and toner cartridges

WHAT NOT TO BRING

Items to put in your regular trash

- Alkaline Batteries
- Ammonium nitrate/fertilizer
- Empty Aerosol Cans
- Empty Paint Cans
- Infectious / Biological Wastes
- Smoke Detectors, unless you have 100s

Check trash facility or Board of Health

- Asbestos, more than 55 gallons. Small item wetted & double bagged acceptable.
- Bulky / Non-Hazardous Items
- Commercial / Industrial Waste
- Compressed Gas Cylinders
- Construction Materials
- Fire Extinguishers
- Needles / Syringes - get container & return to Nashoba BOH 978-772-3335
- Propane tanks
- Radiactive Waste
- Tires / PCB's
